


Location of the City of Bocholt

- Structural policy instrument in NRW
- predecessor: Internationale Bauausstellung Emscher Park
- Promotion of intermuncipal cooperation
- awarding by competition: application by self-defined regions
- strategies and ambitious structural developments for the profiling of the Region
- No own funding pool, but priority funding from existing pools
- Region + Biennale/Triennale = REGIONALE






Herding Company 1913 - textile industry in the period of prosperity




World war II - Demolished areas of Bocholt



Demolished textile production in 1945









Green loop system with radial axes








Aims of the KUBAai project




