

Connective Cities at a glance

Since 2014

- More than **2000 participations of local practitioners** in more than **30 thematic workshops**
- More than **200 cities** from a total of **65 countries** were or are active in Connective Cities, of which more than **80** are **from Germany**.
- **Various project ideas developed** in the exchange **are currently implemented** via German or international funding opportunities or on municipal budgets: e.g. in Thailand, Brazil, Jordan, Tunisia, Ukraine, Germany, Lebanon, Mozambique, Turkey and Kenya



BACKGROUND



- **Demand oriented exchange** and learning process **based on concrete local challenges** within the community of practice
- The **City of Dortmund applied for hosting this event** by proposing the topic of climate proofing urban development. Dortmund co-organised the event by providing its expertise on the topic and by mobilising relevant local stakeholders.

To facilitate worldwide **networking** between urban actors from politics, administration, business, science and civil society


To support a systematic and application-oriented **exchange and joint learning** on good practices and through peer-to-peer-consultations


DIALOGUE EVENTS IN FOUR STEPS



Dialogue event as starting point for a learning process




Learning and exchange process
