- More than 2000 participations of local practitioners in more than 30 thematic workshops
- More than **200 cities** from a total of **65 countries** were or are active in Connective Cities, of which more than **80** are **from Germany**.
- Various project ideas developed in the exchange are currently implemented via German or international funding opportunities or on municipal budgets: e.g. in Thailand, Brazil, Jordan, Tunisia, Ukraine, Germany, Lebanon, Mozambique, Turkey and Kenya








Learning and exchange process
