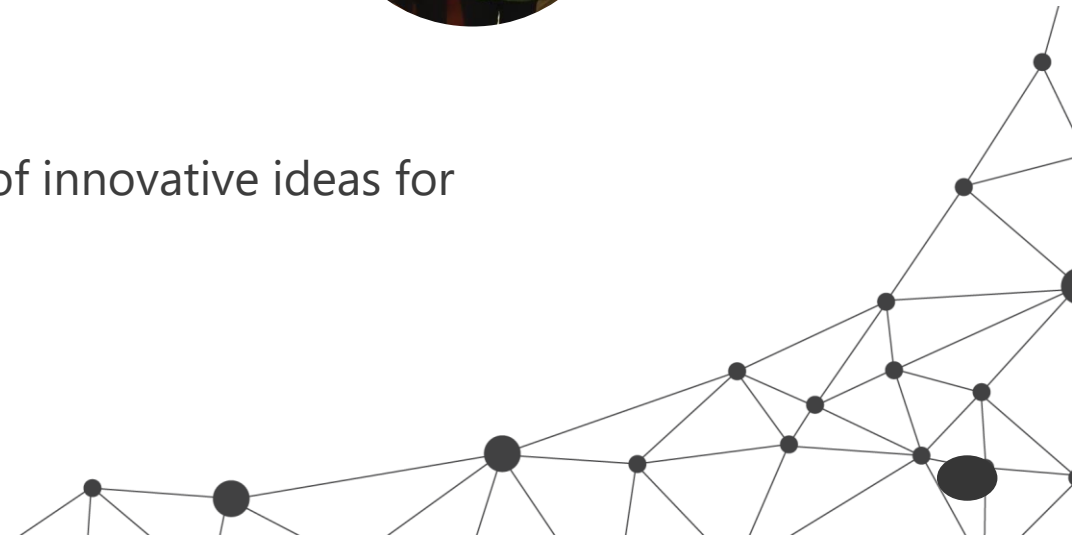


To facilitate worldwide **networking** between urban actors from politics, administration, business, science and civil society

Creation of a waste recovery plan

- Developing a task force with public consultation, supervised by a steering committee, with relevant stakeholders, approved by local authorities

Provision of adequate funding

- Lobbying the county assembly and engaging development partners

Improvement of market access for recyclables

- Conducting a market survey for recyclables,
- Building capacities and setting incentives for local companies and residents

Increase awareness among residents

- Conduct public campaigns, design and disseminate info material in cooperation with education partners

Positive side effects

- Extension of landfill lifespan
- Reduced costs for SW operations
- Job creation
- Climate change mitigation

Background

Civil war in Syria; burden and challenges of host communities in Lebanon, Jordan, Turkey

Programme has been launched by the BMZ in 2016; pilot phase until end of 2018. Second phase 2019-2021

Objective

To promote cooperative partnerships between the host communities in Jordan, Lebanon and Turkey on the one hand and German municipalities on the other. The focus is on professional dialogue and constructive cooperation b7w the partner municipalites for the joint development of local solutions.

- Intercultural **qualification**
- Support in the identification process of **thematic areas** for joint projects and during project implementation

- **Financial support** for the initiation and implementation of project partnerships ("Quick Starter Packages")

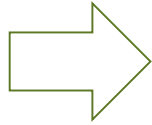
