Access to the labour market for refugees

persons with a residence permit	persons with permission to reside	persons with temporary suspension of deportation status
positive notice from the Federal Office may as a matter of principle work on an employed basis without restrictions	permission to engage in work from their immigration authority	permission to engage in work from their immigration authority

Integration courses for asylum applicants

- Individuals with permission to reside (Aufenthaltsgestattung) and good prospects to remain
- Individuals whose deportation has been temporarily suspended in accordance with section 60 a subs. 2 sentence 3 of the Residence Act (AufenthG)
- Individuals with a residence permit (Aufenthaltserlaubnis) in accordance with section 25 subs. 5 of the Residence Act



Project: Refugees in work

- The project is for 20 people
- Participants are between 18 and 35 years old and needs a language level B1
- „Learn-architects“ help the participants between the whole progress
- The language course is more like a technical language course and important for the work

→ The pilot-project be financed from the district administration Tempelhof-Schöneberg
