# Starting Point

## REFUGEES

- Barriers to access community services including sports
- Social and geographical isolation
- Lack of new perspectives
- Activities and qualifications are often not suited for their needs

## SPORTS CLUBS

- Decreasing number of volunteers in sports clubs
- Diversity in players ≠ diversity in leaders
- Lack of intercultural awareness and understanding of refugee issues
- Prejudice (open or unknowing)
- Lack of guidelines and training for clubs





# Institutional Setting

- Bureaucratic challenges to football participation
- Refugees stating need for adapted qualification courses
- Clubs lack knowledge on inclusive practices and support
- Collaboration with multiple stakeholders
- CHoG open training groups since 2012
- Start2coach pilot project in 2017
- Multiple stakeholders

# Outputs

90 refugees to be trained as coaches,  
paired up with 90 local club coaches and  
work with 1800 young people on a  
weekly basis

## Participants:

- temporarily forget daily worries
- develop self-esteem & self-worth
- build a network
- opportunity to develop transferable skills and practice their German

## Clubs:

- More diverse role models & ability to carry out activities
- Learn to create inclusive practices





# Lessons Learned

- „Neutral“ position enables better club collaborations & geographical distribution
- Multiple tandems per club increase peer-support and club-identification with project
- Social media and cooperations key to communication
- Different approach needed to include female refugees
- Challenges: changing personal circumstances and needs over time, managing expectations

# Transfer

- „Pool“ of potential participants
- Adequate resources and skills for support
- Concept transferable to other team sports
