- To strengthen host municipalities by exchange of know-how with German partners

Middle East Starter Package I: Formal guidelines



Who can submit applications?

- German municipal administrations and companies, municipal policy bodies and municipal associations and district administrations

When can projects be requested?

- on an ongoing basis
- The maximum term is 12 months.
- The measures must be implemented throughout the year.

Treptow-Köpenick – Tepebaşı/Eskişehir 2018:

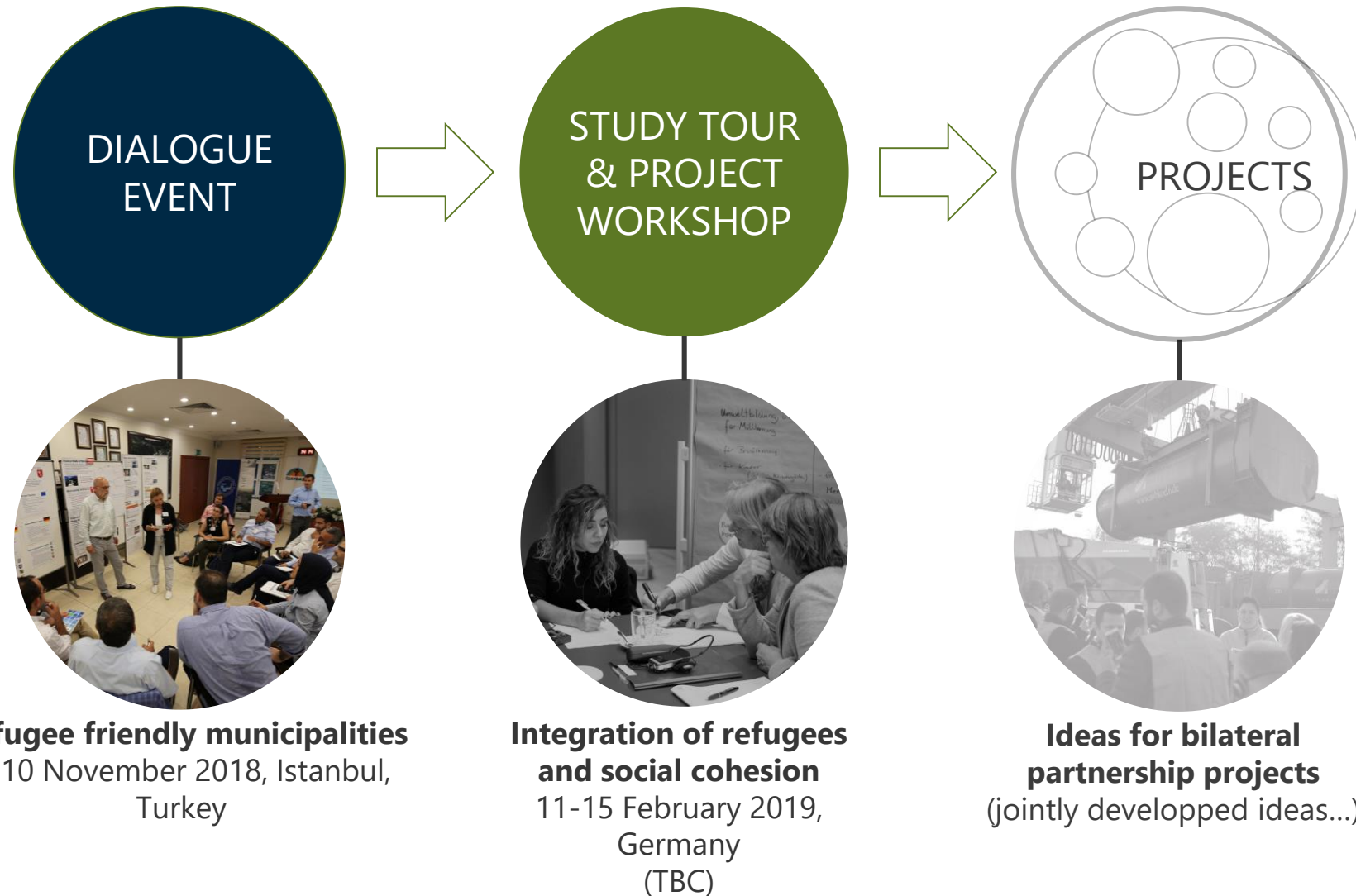
Exchange about creating sustainable business start-ups in the area of creative social entrepreneurship

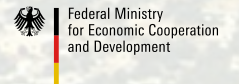

Who can submit applications?

- German municipal administrations and companies, municipal policy bodies and municipal associations and district administrations

When can projects be requested?

- on an ongoing basis
- The maximum term is 36 months

Size of the grant:

- between 50,000 and 250,000 Euros (full financing)
