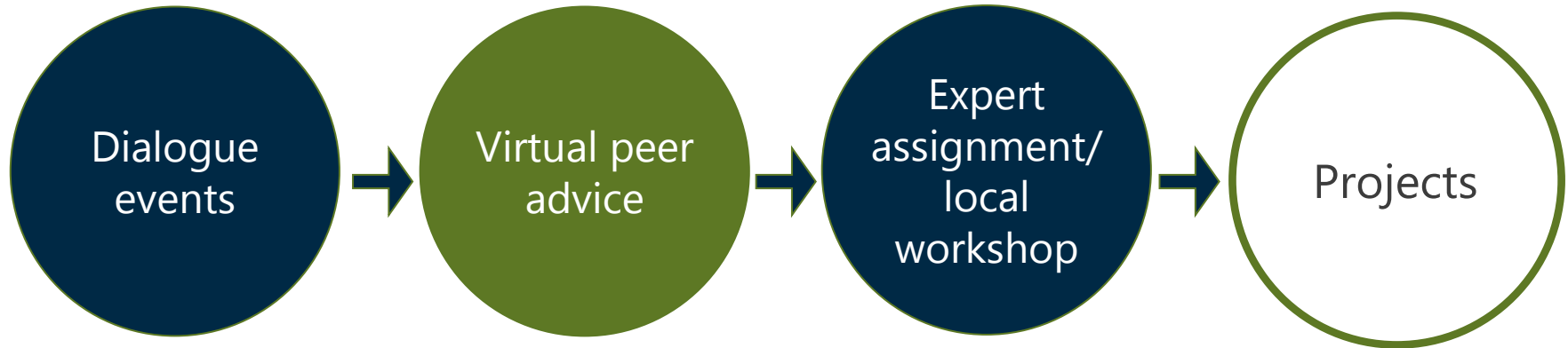

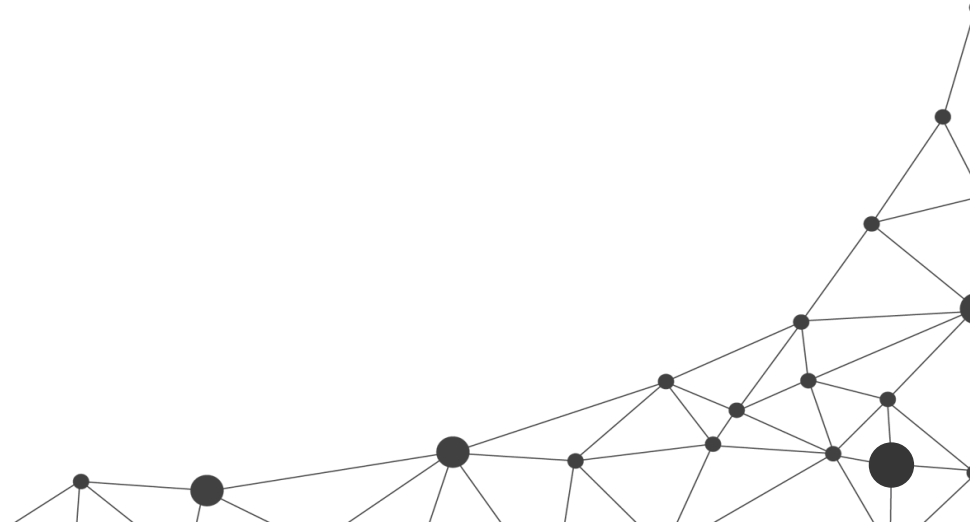
1. **Dialogue events: exchanging experience and develop project ideas**

New phase of Connective Cities



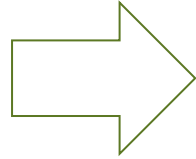
