MOBILITY STATION "MÜNCHNER FREIHEIT"

Mixed-use mobility stations connecting public traffic with shared, individual transport

By placing mobility stations in a highly visible location at road junctions and public transport stops, attractive areas are gained for car-sharing vehicles and rental bicycles. With sufficient, preferably covered, bicycle racks for private bicycles, intermodal route chains in particular are facilitated. The stations should be clearly marked, for example by a corporate design that includes all means of transport offered here, a stele and by signposts in the nearby surroundings. When planning new neighborhoods, appropriate areas should be taken into account from the outset.







