- A greener & cleaner City sustained by the beautification program incorporated in the NCC Strategic Plan.

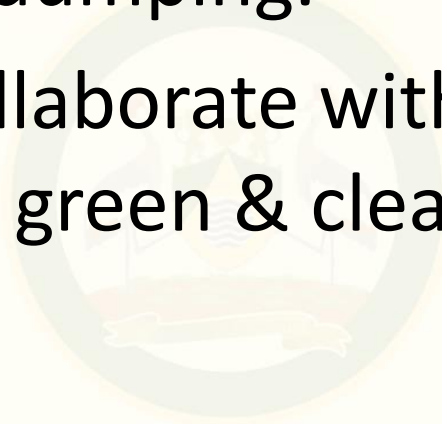


# Lessons
