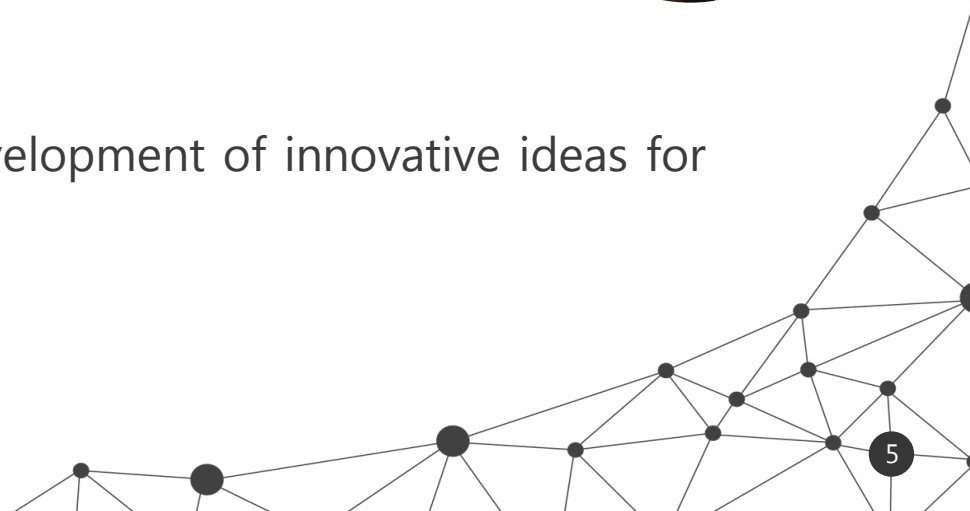


To facilitate worldwide **networking** between urban actors from politics, administration, business, science and civil society
