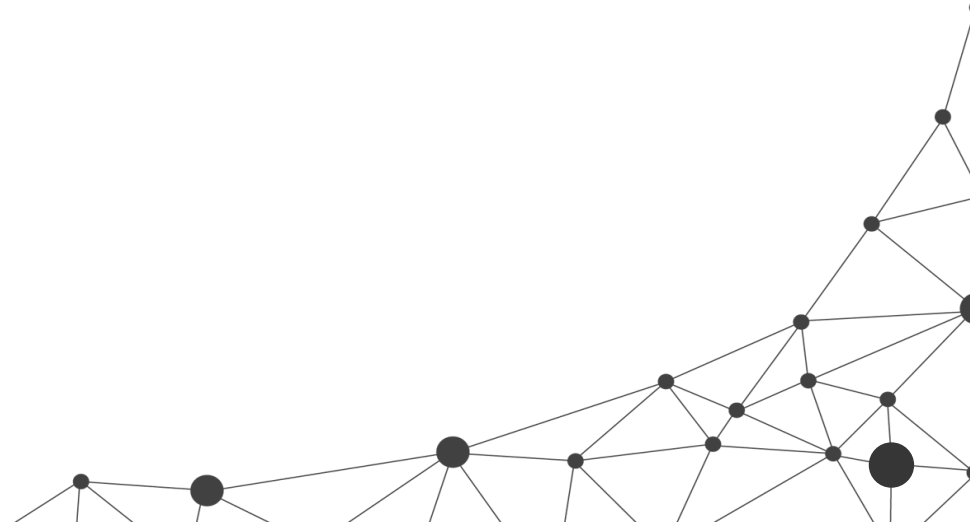
- Support German municipalities in their engagement for development in the Jordanian, Lebanese and Turkish host communities

# OBJECTIVES

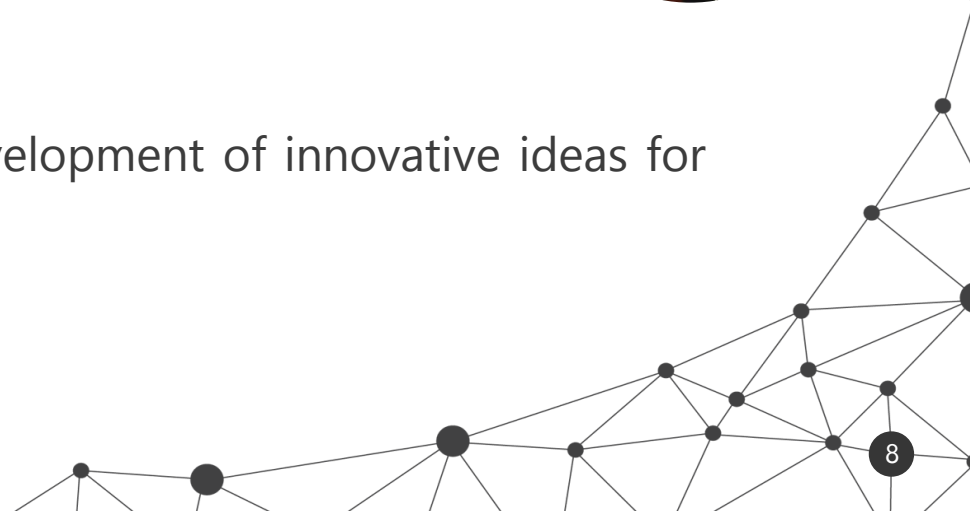


To facilitate worldwide **networking** between urban actors from politics, administration, business, science and civil society
