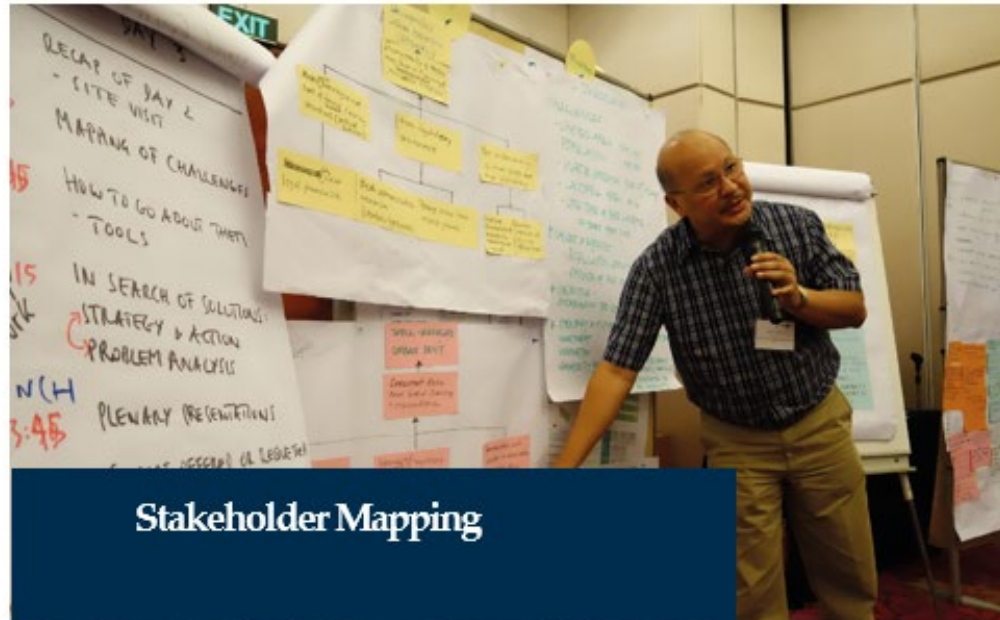


Problem Tree

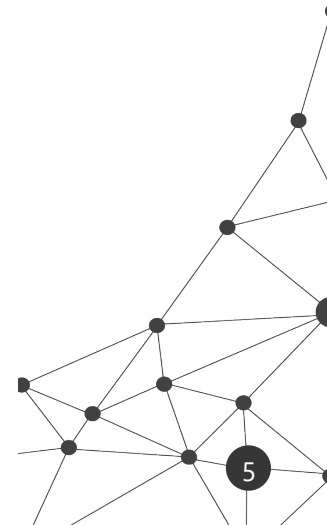
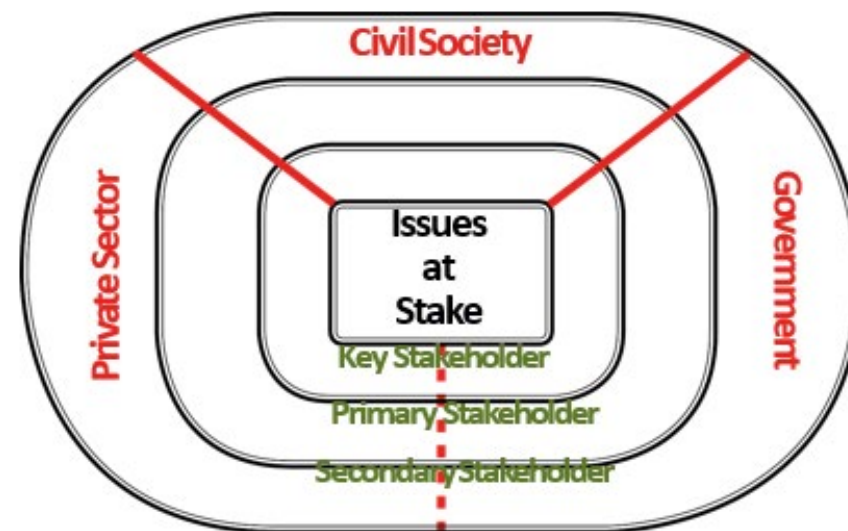

Stakeholder Mapping

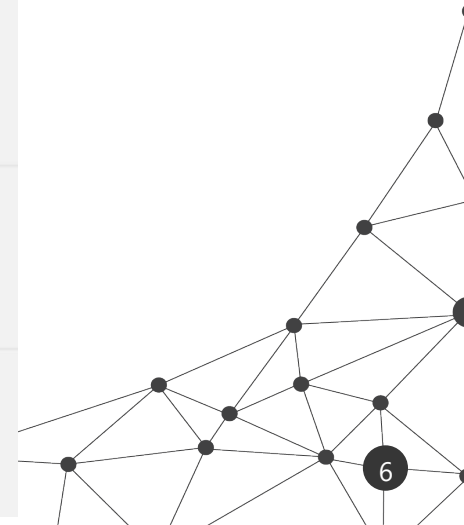
