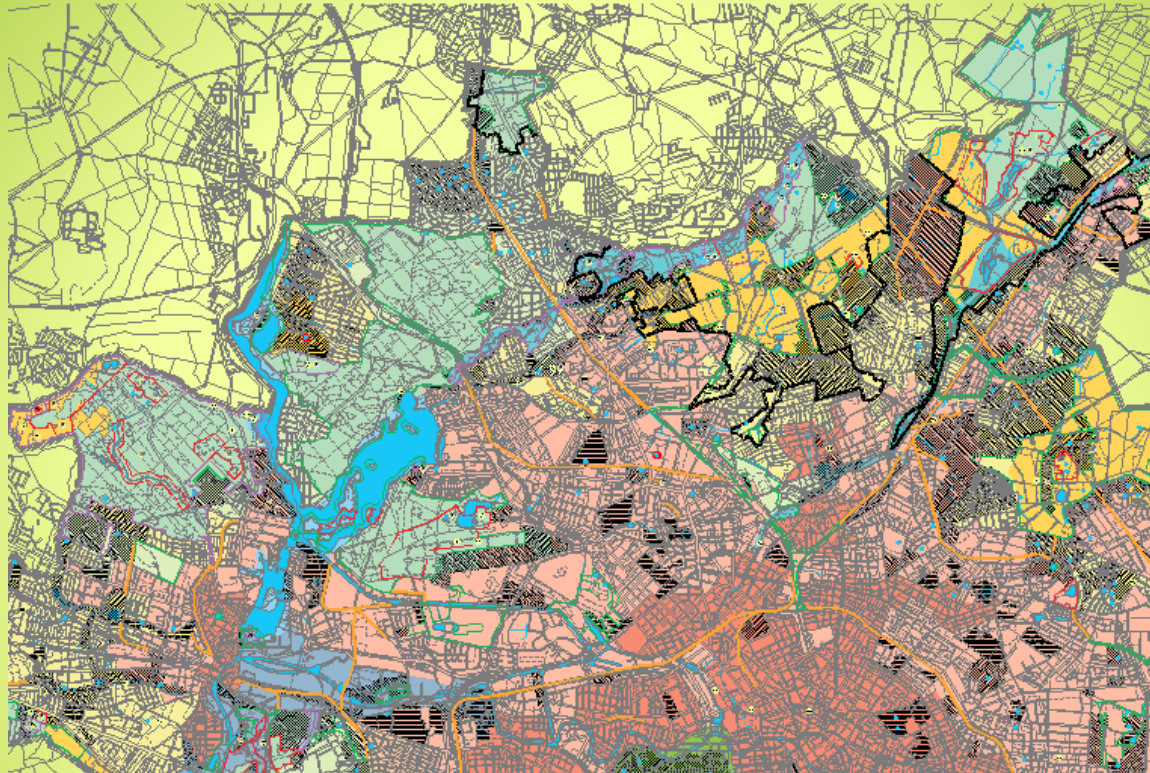
Every citizen in Germany consumes 1050 t of food every year.

to nutrition in Berlin**

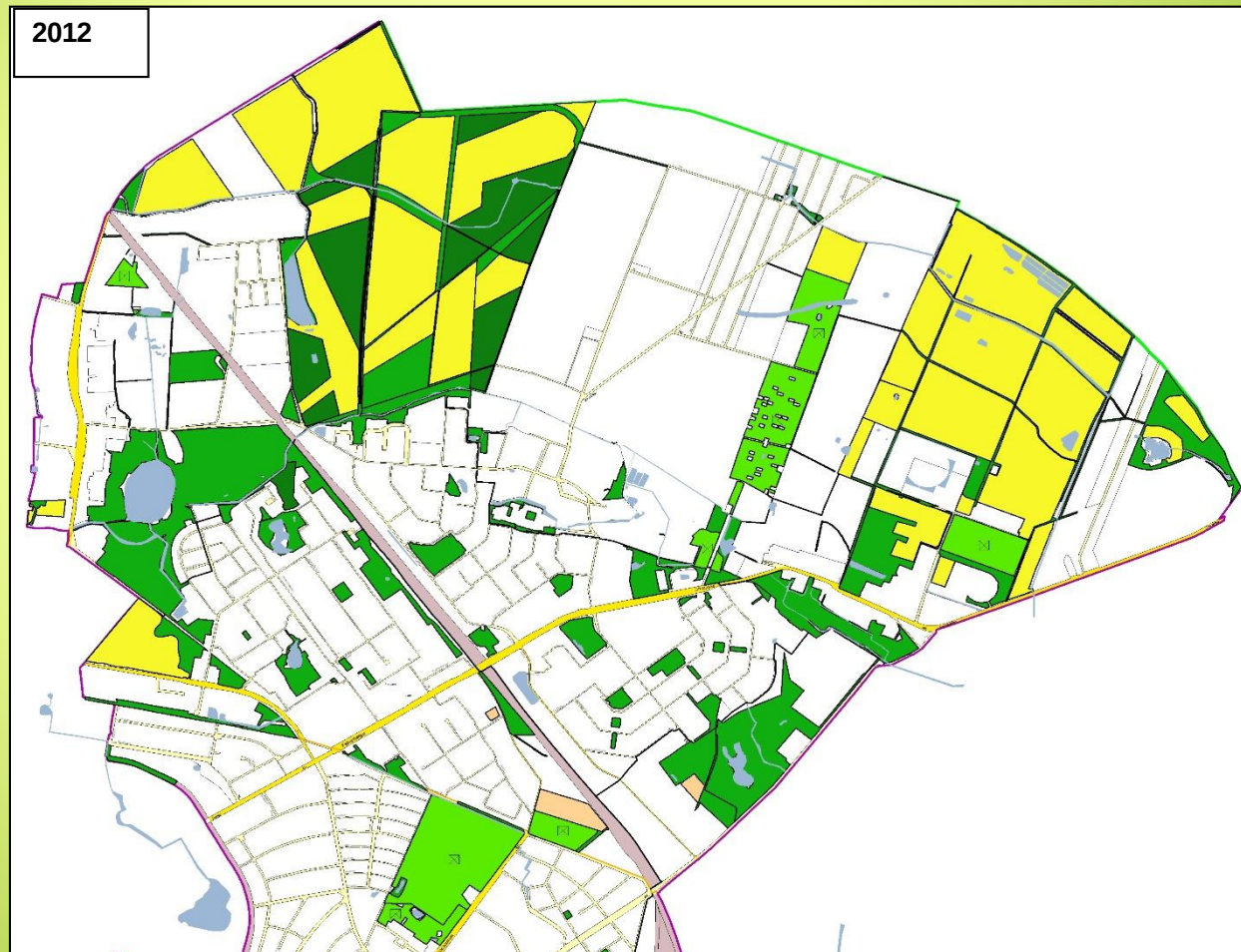
**but it is important for landscape

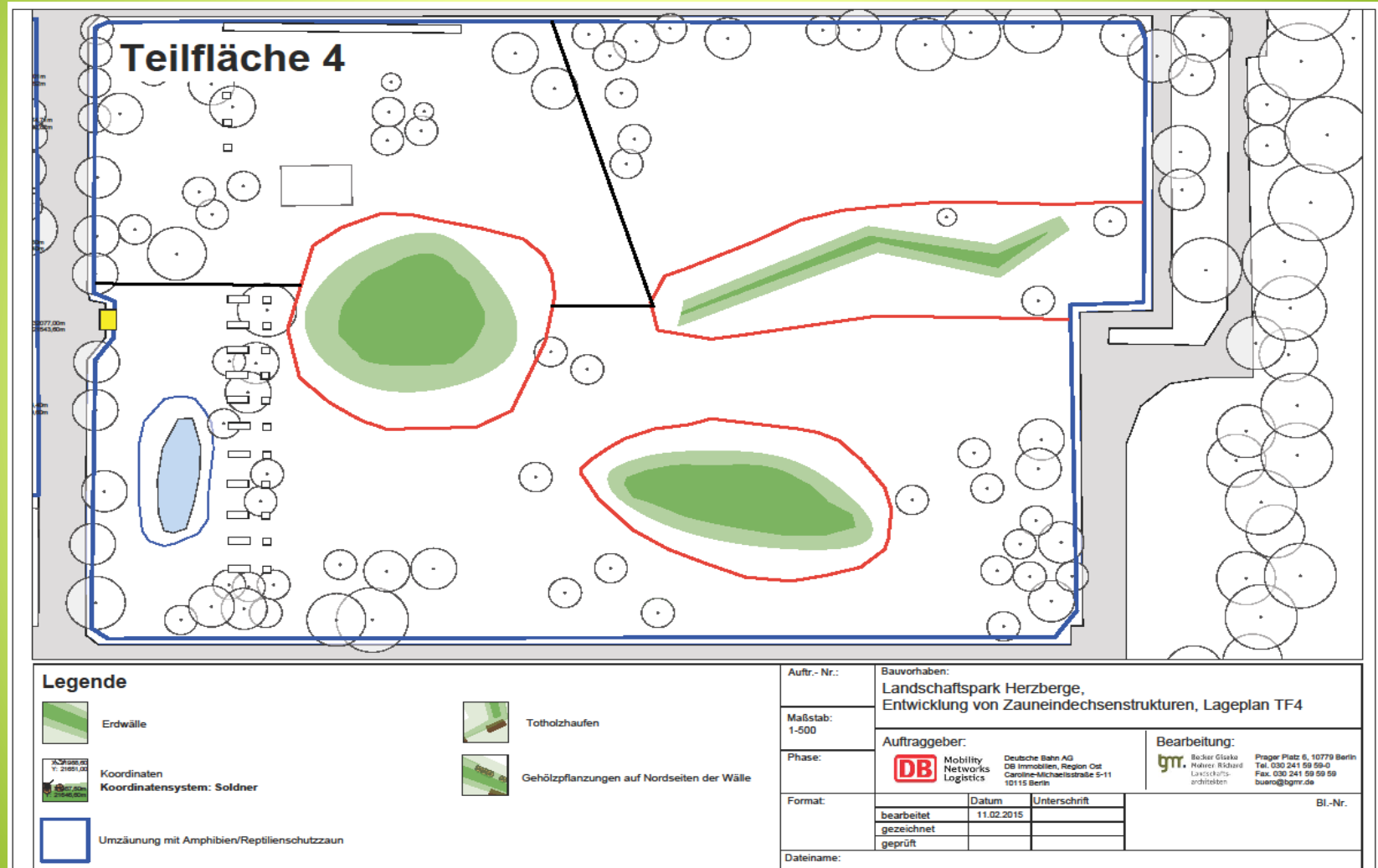
